BACKGROUND

Forum for African Women Educationalists (FAWE) Uganda Chapter is one of the 35 National Chapters of Forum for African Women Educationalists (FAWE), a pan African Non-Governmental Organization (NGO) founded in 1992 by five women ministers of education to promote girls' and women's education in Africa. FAWE Uganda, a membership organisation was established in 1997 and in February 2022 marked her Silver Jubilee with a theme "Breaking Barriers to Girls' Future through Education towards education with the goal of accelerating female participation in education and closing the gender gap within the education system at all levels in Uganda.

FAWE Uganda appreciates that while access to education is important, it should be of good quality, which underpins what the right to education is all about. FAWE Uganda has thus put greater emphasis in responding to this notable challenge of equity and quality of education in Uganda. Uganda Vision 2040, recognizes the need to provide assistance to people who are vulnerable either by age, social class, location, disability, sex, disaster or do not earn any income.

The organizations work is embedded in four thematic areas of; policy influence for girl-child education, fostering positive practices and attitudes, FAWE Uganda evolving into a one center for girl-child education and transform into a strong learning and gender responsive organization.

FAWE Uganda is unique because of its inherent focus on girls and women’s education and empowerment while working with both boys and men. Holistic interventions are implemented with the aim of addressing root causes of problems facing communities i.e. school based projects are focused on guaranteeing a conducive learning environment through working closely with learners, teachers, school administrators and management committees. FAWE Uganda has been in existence since 1997 and successfully implemented numerous innovative programs including; Education scholarships and social services in emergency situation, Adolescent Sexual Reproductive Health, efforts on ending all forms of violence against children and gender based violence, Gender Equality promotion of Science Education and Innovation, and poverty alleviation through skilling and livelihoods development for marginalized groups including young women and girls.
